This is concerning your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request dated February 8, 2007 and received at the National Park Service's FOIA office on March 28, 2007, seeking documents relating to NPS' weapons regulations. (Request No. NPS-2007-00335)

Our regulations state (43 C.F.R. § 2.17), a requester must specify his/her fee category, and provide written assurance of his/her willingness to pay all of the fees associated with processing his/her request unless he/she has been granted a fee waiver.

Regarding your request, we have classified your request as an "All Others" request, meaning that you are required to pay for search time and duplication fees, however, you will received the first 2 hours of search time and the first 100 pages of duplication free of charge. You have agreed to pay up to \$50.00 for the processing of this request.

However, after our preliminary search, and after your entitlements, we **estimate** that it will cost the following:

The Department charges the following fees for the processing of FOIA requests:


Clerical search/review time	\$5.20 per ¼ hour

We will not continue processing your request until we have in writing your willingness to pay the fees. At this time, you may wish to modify the scope of your FOIA to reduce the fees. (43 CFR § 2.18(b)(i)(ii)) If we do not hear from you, with respect to issues relating to either the scope of your request (43 CFR § 2.8(a)(3)) or to unresolved fee issues

(43 CFR § 2.18(d)) within 20 workdays of this letter notifying you of these issues, we will assume that you are no longer interested in this matter and will close the file on this request.
